Due to the dynamics of the current global pandemic, Our House Addiction Recovery Centre has made the difficult decision to cease the intake of new clients at this time.

We are working closely with Alberta Health Services and our Medical Director to ensure that we are doing everything necessary to keep our clients and staff safe.

At this time, clients are not permitted to leave on overnight passes or go into the community unless approved by our Executive Director and for essentials only.

We are not permitting visitors or meetings to occur currently. We are only allowing essential service contractors on site.

We have multiple staff self-isolating or at home due to having young children. All staff have been set up to be able to work from home and do counseling sessions either on the phone or through Skype.
